

# T2 Return to Campus Award – Terms and Conditions

## Terms and Conditions

### 1. Background

The T2 Return to Campus Award is available to commencing students from eligible countries to undertake studies at a highly ranked Australian university. The Award is open to all commencing students with defined citizenships enrolled full time in an eligible undergraduate or postgraduate coursework degree.

### 2. Eligibility

- a) To be eligible for the Award, applicants must be an international student as defined in the Higher Education Support Act 2003.
- b) Applicants must hold citizenship of a country/ region listed in Attachment A. Proof of citizenship will be required.
- c) Applicants must have an offer of admission for a new undergraduate or postgraduate coursework degree in Term 2 2023 at UNSW to be offered the Award.
- d) The Award is not applicable to students studying a Master of Laws (9201), Bachelor of Computer Science (3778), Graduate Certificate in Computing (7543), Graduate Diploma in Information Technology (5543), Master of Information Technology (8543), programs offered by AGSM, UNSW Online, UNSW Canberra, UNSW Foundation Programs, UNSW Diploma, Transition Program Online, any program taught in the Hexamester calendar or Study Abroad students; and
- e) The Award is only applicable to degrees where tuition fees are payable to UNSW.
- f) The Award is non-refundable or transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash or further credit.
- g) The Award is only applicable to coursework degrees. In the case of a combined coursework and research degree, the Award is only applicable to the coursework component of the combined degree.
- h) The Award is applicable to new students commencing in an eligible term where the Award is offered. Students who have completed an undergraduate program at UNSW and are commencing a postgraduate program will be considered a new student for the purposes of the Award.

### 3. Selection Criteria

- a) To be successful in obtaining the Award, applicants will need to meet the entry criteria for admission to an undergraduate or postgraduate coursework degree at UNSW.

#### **4. Value**

- a) The Award is valued at \$15,000 for commencing undergraduate students, and \$10,000 for commencing postgraduate students.
- b) No payment will be made directly to the student, the Award will be applied to the applicant's record which will reduce the applicant's tuition fee liability.
- c) No other amount is payable.

#### **5. Ongoing eligibility**

- a) To continue receipt of the Award, the recipient must:
  - a. have no outstanding fees
  - b. maintain full time enrolment
  - c. be enrolled in an eligible program

#### **6. Termination**

- a) The Award will be terminated if the recipient:
  - I. withdraws from an eligible program or fails to enrol
  - II. becomes a domestic student as defined in the Higher Education Support Act 2003
  - III. is determined by the University to be guilty of serious misconduct, including, but not limited to, having provided false or misleading information as part of their application; or
  - IV. any other provision as indicated in these terms that would lead to termination.

#### **7. Other Requirements**

Award recipients may be invited to promote the program in which they are enrolled as well as represent UNSW at student events, marketing events and corporate networking events. The costs of representing UNSW at these functions will be met by the University.
