● UNSW Scholarships

Every year UNSW provides over \$83 million in scholarships to help students of all circumstances reach their educational goals. Scholarships are offered in a range of broad categories including rural, Indigenous, academic merit, sporting, equity, accommodation, travel and exchange, as well as for specific degrees and faculties. To be considered for a scholarship, all you have to do is submit an application online by the deadline.

Merit

Merit scholarships recognise students who demonstrate exceptional academic achievements or other outstanding qualities, with the potential to succeed in their chosen field.

Equity

Equity scholarships assist students who may experience financial or other educational disadvantage with the costs of tertiary study and help them reach their academic potential.

Rural

Rural scholarships provide support to eligible students who may have to move from rural, regional or remote areas in order to study at UNSW.

Sporting

Sports scholarships aim to support outstanding athletes to obtain a world class education whilst continuing to compete as an elite athlete in their chosen sport.

Indigenous

Indigenous scholarships are offered to our Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students to encourage academic excellence and provide support for the costs of tertiary education.

Accommodation

Accommodation scholarships assist with the costs of living in the Residential Communities on campus, which includes Colleges and apartments for independent living.

Honours

Honours scholarships encourage and support outstanding undergraduates to undertake an Honours year or research program related to their degree.

Travel/Exchange

Scholarships are offered to UNSW students to undertake a period of study overseas on exchange with our global network of over 200 partner institutions in 39 countries.

Faculty/Program

Various awards and scholarships are on offer to encourage students to apply for and undertake study in particular Faculties or degree programs.

How to apply



How to apply for Merit Scholarships



Merit scholarship applications for future students usually open mid-year and close in September. To apply use the online search tool to see what's available. Start broad by looking for all open scholarships and then narrow it down by faculty, program, rural, Indigenous, academic, travel, sporting, etc. Scholarships can be added at any time, so keep looking!

How to apply for Equity Scholarships



Equity scholarships are applied for through UAC and usually close early January. Check out our website to find out which scholarships require a UAC application and find out how to apply for Equity Scholarships (ES) and the Educational Access Scheme (EAS) at uac.edu.au.

Scholarships based on ATAR results



Some scholarships programs require no application because they are awarded by UNSW based on ATAR results.

UNSW Scientia Scholarships: \$10,000 pa for duration of degree plus academic mentor, offered to students with an ATAR of 99.90+ or IB score of 45 (limited number only available for Medicine).

Academic Achievement Award (AAA): \$4,000 for one year plus 3 bonus points, for the highest ATAR from NSW and ACT schools.

One Stop Shop

Once you register and enter your details, you can apply for as many scholarships as you are eligible. The general questions will be used for all scholarships you apply for.
